

Yellow Bags

Worth knowing:

Every household gets a role with 26 yellow bags. If required, you can get more yellow bags at your city hall for free. If the yellow bag is full, you can give it away at the buyback centre.

Buyback centre – new opening hours 2018:

Wednesday + Friday from 13-17 o'clock / Saturday 9-13 o'clock

Still, you can give away following things at the buyback centre:

Scrap, glass, old clothes, paper, carton, lamps, battery, rechargeable battery, neon tube, edible fat, CDs, corks,...

Plus, little electrics like:

Radio, telephone, video recorder, blow-dryer, flat iron, table lamps, laptops, mobile phones, camera,...

Not allowed are big electrics like:

Fridge, freezer, cooker, dishwasher, washing machine, dryer, microwave, ironing machine, TVs, monitors,...

Therefore, it's necessary to buy a token coin which has a value of 8€. You can get these at the city hall or the citizens' centre. You have to stick the token coin on your electrics and then they pick up your electrics in front of your house or you give it away in a shop.

When is the pickup of your yellow bag?

Every two weeks they pick up the yellow bags. They have to be closed and on the pickup day they have to be clearly seen at the curb side until 6 o'clock in the morning.

The things you put in the yellow bag should be cleaned and without any grope remains.

The different synthetic materials have to be cleaned before they can get recycled because we want to avoid inclusions and pollution.

After we pick up the yellow bags we have to collate the different recyclable fractions into groups and sort the contraries out per hand. Because of that, we would appreciate if you could not boozed the aluminium foil and bowls and please do not stick the cups into each other. This makes the Collation more complicated, even when it's good-willing and space-saving.

Yellow bags with wrong contents cumber the collection and collation. As a consequence, these yellow bags are not going to be picked up.

Where you can get yellow bags?

You can get yellow bags at the city hall, the buyback centre, the Environmental Agency or the citizens' centre.

It's not allowed to use the yellow bags for collection of retail pack.

Please consider:

The consequence of misuse is an increase in price of the Collecting system and this returns finally to the consumers.

The following things are allowed in the yellow bag:

Cups – Yoghurt, ice, cream, margarine, quark,..

Mixed plastics - Foils - shopping bags, packing,..

Aluminium – foils, yoghurt lid, grill bowls,..

Material with aluminium or foil

PET-bottles – Drinks, dish liquid, vinegar,..

Plastic containers – canister, bucket, dish and washing agent,..

Tetra Packs – Milk, Wine, juice

Tin can
